



Audio Contest

Students: Crime Stoppers is offering you the opportunity to create a compelling radio broadcast promoting the Project Safe Campus program. Entrants should be creative and original. **Crime Stoppers will select five lucky S.E. Michigan students as grand prize winners of \$100 each and will appear on our website!! !!** The student council of the winning student's school, will also receive \$100 (**maximum of \$100 per Student Council**)

Your goal is to create a convincing radio broadcast that encourages students to use the Project Safe Campus program.

Requirements:

- * The Project Safe Campus broadcast **must** be 10 to 15 seconds long, and contain the process of how to submit an anonymous tip.
- * The broadcast **must** contain the phrase, "Project Safe Campus"
- * The broadcast **must** have the sound of a school function, ex: School bell, cafeteria, etc.
- * The broadcast **must** contain **at least two** of the Crime Stoppers' tip hotline methods which are:
 - **1-800-SpeakUp**
 - www.projectsafecampus.com or
 - **Text csm and your tip to 274637**
- * You **may** include a "slogan" or a "tagline" that YOU create and you may include the "\$100 Cash Reward" tagline.
- * You may put music in your project; however, it must be one of the songs listed on our YouTube page. (On the next page are directions on how to get the music.)
- * You may work in groups of up to 4 students. Your project must be clear, well organized, and professional, **NO PROFANITY!**

Broadcasts should be received by Crime Stoppers no later than **April 21, 2017 at 5 p.m.** Your teacher or student council advisor will mail the poster to us. **Winners will be notified by early May 12, 2017.**



How to turn in project:

Each member of your group must sign the waiver of liability given in the packet individually, and it must also be signed by a parent/guardian, and the principal of your school. Your group must also provide a paper with each member listed, and the responsibilities these members had in the project. Your project will not be qualified if any of these guidelines are not completed.

To turn in your project, place your project in a Jump drive and give the jump drive, waiver, and responsibilities sheet to a teacher or advisor. Remember, the purpose of this project is to inform other people about this program, and how it can positively affect your schools. So have fun, and keep your schools safe!

Your project may or may not be aired on any television stations. Project Safe Campus and Crime Stoppers of Michigan are not responsible for the use of your project, and do not guarantee air time on radio. We appreciate your cooperation in this competition, and will base the winners off of a fair judgment according to the rules and guidelines given to you.

Instructions on how to get music for Audio/TV Contest:

- Pick out which music you would like to use

Then go to: www.youtube-mp3.org

- Copy the URL of the music from YouTube, and paste it on the YouTube to mp3 page
- Press convert video
- Click on the blue “download” button inside the green square
- Save the file to your desk top or a designated folder
- Now you are ready to import that audio for your project!
